

The subject, the sound, it follows that it is a non-product because it is permanent. In the following chart are shown the sign, the predicate and the base of debate (subject) of this consequence.

Sound	A non-product	Permanent	Sound is a non-product	Product	Impermanent

Here below are the possible answers to the debate's questions.

1. I accept it	When it is accepted that that subject is that predicate	Relation between subject & predicate
2. Why?	By asking for a reason the defender shows he does not accept	
3. The reason is not established	Here it is not accepted that that subject is that sign	Relation between subject & sign
4. There is no pervasion	If it is that sign it isn't necessarily that predicate	Relation between sign & predicate
5. The pervasion is opposite	If it is that sign it is necessarily not that predicate	
6. Doubt	Doubt regarding the sign or the predicate & so forth
