


Initial situation of the Hasty Defense scenario

Map 3. 1. PLT positions and ENY locations and activity near HEESKA for HD1 (given to paper and pencil group only)



You are currently in the position DINGO 1. You are located just behind A12 and looking through the binoculars at the landscape in front of you. You see at least one PLT size ENY unit (with IFV-s) in the HEESKA line. In addition to that, you see about two ENY SQUAD-s in the vicinity of HEESKA crossroad, one to the west side and one to the east side of the road. You can also see one ENY bridge carrier northeast of the HEESKA village.

While looking at the landscape in front of you, you get the following information through the radio (starting transmissions are not included, arrow shows who is starting the transmission and to whom the message is being transmitted, respondents' answers to messages are shown in separate rows):

VP1 → A10: two enemy BMP-s, BREAK, moving from southeast towards us, BREAK, distance approximately 200m, BREAK, we are continuing observation, OVER.

A10: ROGER.

A14 → A10: I have an issue here and I would like to get 5 men from some section, I need them to bring those, BREAK, food and class 5 stuff from the bridge area, OVER.

A10: OUT.

You continue looking at the landscape in front of you through the binoculars for some time. You see two BMP-s moving towards your VP1. While looking at the two BMP-s, you get the following information through the radio:

A90 → A10: I have information from L90 that ENY is moving towards HEESKA with company plus size unit, BREAK, I emphasize that maintaining the river line is crucial in my plane, BREAK. Pay special attention to the ENY high payoff targets (HPT), OVER.

A10: ROGER.

A90: OUT.

VP1 → A10: ENY dismounted approximately 150m from us, started moving into woods, towards our PLT left flank BREAK, do we get permission to leave now, OVER.

A10: ROGER, wait, OUT.
