
## Continuous situation of the Hasty Defense scenario

Map1. 1. PLT positions and ENY locations and activity near HEESKA for HD2 (given to paper and pencil group only)



You are still in the position DINGO 1 and located just behind A12 and looking through the binoculars at the landscape in front of you. You still see at least one PLT size ENY unit (with IFV-s) in the HEESKA line and about two ENY SQUAD size units in the vicinity of HEESKA crossroad, one to the west side and one to the east side of the road. You can also still see one ENY bridge carrier northeast of the HEESKA village. In addition to that, now you see that at least one ENY Squad east of HEESKA crossroad has started slowly moving towards you. While looking at the landscape in front of you, you get the following information through the radio (starting transmissions are not included, arrow shows who is starting the transmission and to whom the message is being transmitted, respondents' answers to messages are shown in separate rows):

 $A14 \rightarrow A10$ : I'm still waiting for this half section in vicinity of bridge, BREAK, actually it's really vital I think, BREAK... (radio transmission will continue after informative text)

During radio transmission you hear explosions in your right flank, you turn your heads towards explosions and you see that explosions are in the positions of A13.

 $A14 \rightarrow A10$ : (continues after BREAK)... there is class 5 too, I need people who take it away, OVER.

A10: I will deal with it later, OUT.

You hear now that at the northeast corner of the landscape, ENY opens fire (IFV and hand weapons) on your A13 positions. Shortly after that you get information through radio:

 $A13 \rightarrow A10$ : contact-contact, we are under ENY indirect fire, OVER.

A10: ROGER.

You still see and hear explosions in your A13 positions. Shortly after you get additional information through radio:

A11 → A10: Direction 9 o'clock, ENY, approximately 10 man, BREAK, ENY is dismounted, moving towards our squad, BREAK, left wing, OVER.

A10: ROGER.

Through your binoculars you now see that both ENY squads have crossed the road south of village HEESKA and move slowly towards you.

A13 → A10: Sending CONTACTREP, OVER.

A10: SEND.

A13: A: 200 meters from our positions direction 1 o'clock, BREAK, B: ENY PLT with BMP-s, BREAK, C: attacking our position, influencing with IDF, BREAK, D: right now, BREAK, E: we have one WIA, lost his leg, BREAK, positions are partially destroyed, BREAK, continue with our task, OVER.

A10: ROGER.

While you hear shooting, you also continue to watch the landscape in front of you through your binoculars. You see that ENY has now advanced towards you and is now already south of the crossroad near HEESKA.

A90 → A10: confirm or reject, ENY has crossed EDGAR, OVER.

A10: wait 3, I will clarify and take back to you, OVER.

A90: do it quickly, OVER.

A10: OUT.

You continue to look for information for A90 and watch the landscape in front of you through your binoculars. Shortly you get additional information through radio:

 $A90 \rightarrow A10$ : I have info from L90 that some sort of ENY engineer HPT roves there somewhere in your area, BREAK, our S50 is looking for it, wants to target and shoot it, BREAK, send me its exact coordinates, OVER.

A10: ROGER, I will clarify, OVER.

A90: hurry up, OUT.
