1.2 Are municipal targets regularly assessed?	at least an annual assessment, defining of responsibilities and terms for fulfiling of measurable indicators	evaluation report	monitoring and evaluation report (obliged for Program budget) or other evaluation report	analysis of regularity of assessment and also its quality (not only formal assessment)
1.3 Does the municipality take measures to improve the situation? if municipal targets are not fullfiled	if insufficient effectiveness is identified, necessary action is taken	measures taken	annexes, corresponding documentation about new measures	analysis of the new measures (whether the new measures respond to the identified shortcomings)

2.1 Is the available volume of containers for 1 citizen per year sufficient? (accessibility for citizens)	meeting the collection standard (collection standard is exact formula defined by law – how many litres must be available per year for 1 citizen – for each waste component separately)	collection standard (quantity * frequency)	internal evidence about containers, transport of waste schedule, contracts with collectors	comparison of mandatory values and real values, collection standard re-calculation (correctness of the calculation by municipality) * the standard must be recalculated every year depending on the volume of separated waste in previous year
2.2 Are containers available to everyone? (Allocation of containers and distance for citizens)	containers are within an acceptable distance for citizens	map of containers	information system or other evidence about allocation of containers	analysis of allocation, defining areas whitout containers or big distances for citizens
