- Doctoral education & postdoctoral training & skill development
- Promote excellent (bottom-up) research,
 supervision & career guidance, working conditions
- Facilitate mobility between countries, across disciplines and sectors







COST Actions



- Bottom -up interdisciplinary science & technology networks
- Networking opportunities for researchers off all career levels to meet and discuss ideas, an inclusive career accelerator
- Funding for workshops, conferences, training schools, short-term scientific missions (STSMs), and dissemination activities
- <u>COST</u> does <u>not</u> fund research itself
- Check & join ongoing COST Actions e.g. The Birth of Solar Systems (PLANETS)
